Selective Broad Leaf Weed Killer

This product is designed for control of broad leaf weeds on turf, golf courses, park grounds and other similar non-crop turf areas. In addition to the thoroughroot kill this selective weed killer also gives an impressive top kill. This product is effective year round in cool or warm weather, but for optimum results, use should be in early spring while desirable grass is dormant and weeds are hardy. This selective weed killer is very economical because of its high dilution rate and the reduction of reseeding costs.

WARNING: This product will kill or seriously injure many desirable forms of vegetation. Do not apply directly to flowers, fruits, vegetables, grapes, ornamentals, cotton or other desirable plants. Do not use when there is a hazard from drifting mist. (Coarse sprays are less likely to drift.) Vapors from this product may injure susceptible plants in the immediate vicinity. Avoid contamination of water used for domestic purposes and irrigation purpose. Excessive amounts of this product in the soil may temporarily inhibit seed germination and plant growth.

SPRAY EQUIPMENT: Spray equipment used in applying this product should be thoroughly cleaned before using for any other purpose. Use repeated flushing with soap and warm water or suitable chemical cleaner. It is best to use a separate sprayer for application of insecticides and fungicides.

Coverage: 3-5 Ounces of concentrate in 1-2 gallons of water covers 1,000 square feet.

This product is effective all year in cool or warm weather, but for optimum results, use should be in early spring while desirable grass is dormant and weeds are hardy. This selective weed killer is very economical because of its high dilution rate and the reduction of reseeding costs. It is best to use a separate sprayer for application of insecticides and fungicides. Coverage: 3-5 ounces of concentrate in 1 - 2 gallons of water covers 1,000 square feet. Use four to six quarts of product per acre diluted with water to assure uniform coverage. NOTE: Do not use on newly seeded lawns, do not mow for several days before or after treatment. May damage dichondra, clover, bent grasses, and St. Augustine. This product will kill or injure many desirable plants. Do not apply to fruits, flowers, vegetables or ornamentals. (Note: It is a violation of federal law to use this product in a manner inconsistent with its labeling. See product label copy for specific information.)

CAUTION: Harmful if swallowed or absorbed through the skin. Do not breathe vapors or spray mist. When using this product, wear long-sleeved shirt, long pants, socks, shoes and chemical resistant gloves. A mechanical system (probe and pump) must be used for transferring the contents of this container. If the contents of a non-refillable pesticide container are emptied, the probe must be rinsed before removal. Do not get in eyes, on skin or on clothing. In case of contact immediately flush eyes or skin with plenty of water. Get medical attention if irritation persists. Do not allow people (other than applicator) or pets on treatment area during application. Do not enter treatment area until spray has dried or dust has settled. After using this product, rinse gloves before removing, remove clothing and launder separately before reuse and promptly and thoroughly wash hands and exposed skin with soap and water. Remove saturated clothing as soon as possible and shower. Do not apply directly to water. Do not contaminate water by cleaning of equipment or disposal of wastes. IF

SWALLOWED: Call a physician or Poison Control Center immediately. Drink one or two glasses of water and induce vomiting by touching the back of the throat with finger. Repeat until vomit fluid is clear. Do not induce vomiting or give anything by mouth to any unconscious person. IF IN EYES: Flush with plenty of water. See a physician if irritation persists. IF ON SKIN: Remove contaminated clothing and wash affected areas with soap and water. IF INHALED: Remove victim to fresh air. Apply artificial respiration if indicated.
